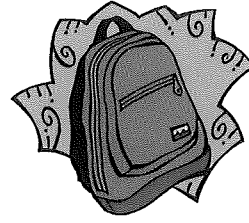


Kindergarten Supply List



Please label the following three items with your child's name.

- One standard sized backpack, without wheels (large enough to fit a folder, lunch box, and cold weather gear)
- One pair of USB headphones to be kept at school (please send them in a Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name) No earbuds, please!

Please supply the following items if you are financially able to do so. All supplies listed below are shared, so please **do not** label the following items with your child's name.

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 tubs of Clorox wipes
- 2 boxes of Dixie cups
- 1 pack of napkins
- 10 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

We also suggest sending in an extra set of clothing to be kept in your child's locker in case of accidents or spills. Please label the clothing with your child's name.

Recommended Supply List for First Graders



- 1 large backpack (no wheels)LABEL
- 2 boxes of 24 crayons (1 box to be saved for later in the year)
- 1 plastic pencil box(standard size) (this can be labeled with the child's name)
- Erasers (not pencil top ones)
- 3 - **1 subject notebooks** (wide ruled) --** **Please get these colors - one BLUE, one RED, one YELLOW, and one GREEN** (nothing with special characters or designs)
- 4 - duotang folders --**PLASTIC/POLY** material (not paper) *****Please get these colors - 1 blue, 1 green, 1 red, and 1 yellow** (nothing with special characters or designs)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 8 glue sticks (these will be collected and shared in class)
- **Headphones** to use with our Chromebooks (these should be labeled and put in a ziplock bag) **Please try and buy headphones that have a USB connection rather than the 3mm jack.**
- 1 container of Clorox/Lysol Wipes

**Some other items we will use throughout the year are: paper bags, plastic ware, paper plates, napkins, etc. You may send those in if you wish or we will let you know when things arise.

Many activities in first grade revolve around working in cooperative learning groups. When school supplies are readily available the students are able to manage their time more efficiently. School supplies are easily mixed up between children, so we are asking you to **PLEASE** not send in any "special" items with your child. Items such as stamps, pens, fancy pencils, crayons, markers, folders, pencil sharpeners, etc., cause a lot of distraction for first graders, and often end up being sent home because of this. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Here is a suggested supply list for second grade.

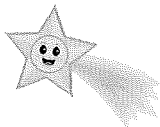
USB headphones/earbuds (Label and place in a secure container)

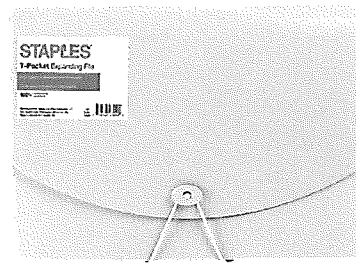
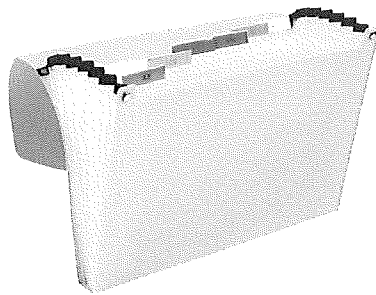

Below is a suggested supply list for the 5th grade.

One Plastic Expandable Reinforced 7 Pocket File, Letter Size (any color)

Spiral notebooks (5 total); students will need spiral notebooks for the following:

- Math (It may be helpful to buy *two spiral notebooks for math* since we have two math workbooks for the year!)
- Science
- Social Studies
- ELA
 - Please label these notebooks prior to coming to school. Write the subject and your child's first and last name.

2 packages of #2 pencils

2 pens (blue or black)

2 red pens

3 Highlighters (3 different colors preferred)

Scissors

Crayons, colored pencils, markers (water-based markers only; no permanent markers)

Glue Sticks (We run out of these quickly!)

Handheld pencil sharpener

Container for supplies

Headphones or earbuds in a resealable bag clearly labeled with your child's name. Please make sure they have a **USB Plug IN**.

*Your child **does not** need any three-ring binders or folders this year.

Optional (but much needed) shared classroom supplies

1 or 2 boxes of Kleenex

1 bottle of hand sanitizer

1 or 2 containers of disinfectant wipes (Clorox, Lysol)

1 package of loose-leaf lined paper (already hole punched)

*Please make sure that all items that are not shared classroom supplies are labeled with your child's name.
